Sunday 9th September - Partnership in Missional Church - what is God doing here and how can we join in?

Across the Oxford Diocese, churches are taking part in a three-year process called Partnership in Missional Church (PMC). This helps local congregations deepen their fellowship while engaging their wider communities to find out where God is already at work and join in with His plans. PMC starts with a process of structured listening to the congregation before reaching outwards to the local communities. St. Mary's Burghfield is on this journey. Members of the congregation have already been selected randomly and interviewed to hear their views of church. We now want to invite the whole congregation to come together and collect memories of church, so that we can build a timeline of how St. Mary's has featured in people's lives. Revd. Glynn and the PCC would like to invite all members of the congregation to join us on Sunday 9th September for an event we're calling "Making Church Memories". There is only one morning service at 10:00 and afterwards we will set up a timeline (history) of St. Mary's church for everyone to add dates and events that matter to them. There will be coffee and cake to assist proceedings, which should only take an hour or so. There will be short presentations about PMC and the "Making Church Memories" event at the end of the services on 2nd September. Meanwhile if you have any questions about PMC, please contact Don Sinclair or Carol Jackson-Doerge via the Parish Office.
